**At all World Championships the accommodation fees shall be payable by bank transfer or credit card as detailed above (Exceptions may be granted by the IPF EC).**

**By bank transfer as specified by the organizer in the invitation for each World Event; payment must be received at the account of the organizer 7 days prior the beginning of the Championships.**

**By credit card, in cash in Rand or in Euros according to the actual exchange currency rate.**

**All bank charges go at the expense of order party. If you choose the payment by bank transfer or by credit card, you must inform the organizer in advance.**

**The organizer will not be responsible for any hotel bills of the participating Nations. Each Team manager will be responsible. All the rooms must be booked at the latest with the deadline of the final nomination – 18 October 2010. After the deadline the organizer cannot guarantee accommodation. Type of accommodation will be reserved on payment.**

**Arrivals/Transportation:** Transport from OLIVER TAMBO (JOHANNESBURG) International Airport to meet hotel. Max. 90 minutes drive. Bus will be provided 55 EURO PER PERSON from Airport To Potchefstroom and return to Airport..

**Scales:** Scales available at hotel and venue.

**Training:** at VENUE – Puk gym is equipped with brand new HAMMER STRENGTH APPARATUS.

**Flag and anthem:** Each nation must bring their flag for podium pictures.

**Photos:** Identification is necessary for security reasons; each nation must send one photo for each lifter, coach and official. A maximum of three coaches will be allowed into the venue warm up area.. Photos must be sent together with the final nominations. If possible, send a digital version by mail.

**ALL ATHLETES MANAGERS AND COACHES ARE INVITED TO THIS PARTY FREE OF CHARGE.**

**Closing Banquet:** Saturday, 13. November 2010 at 19.30 hours, site will be announced on arrival.

**Price for banquet ticket:** 25 EURO per person

**Entry Fee:** 30 EURO for each lifter declared must be paid by wire transfer to the IPF account.

**Anti-Doping Fee:** 50 EURO for each lifter declared must be paid by wire transfer to the IPF account.

**Opening Ceremony:** 08 November 2010, at the venue 10h00

**Health and Travel Insurance:** All delegate members must have a valid health insurance. The organiser and the IPF will not incur any expenses for a doctor or a stay in hospital. We recommend a travel insurance for covering loss of luggage, theft, delayed planes etc.

Please ensure that your athletes & team officials possess the requisite insurance coverage to meet current requirements.

**Nominations:** Team nomination forms must be in the hands of the Meet Director and IPF Championship Secretary not later than:

**Preliminary:** 9. September 2010 (**preliminary form must be sent. No final nomination can be accepted if the preliminary was not sent**)

**Final:** 18. October 2010 (Later entries will not be accepted)

All nominated lifters and officials must cover all Hotel costs if we have received no information about a cancellation 7 days prior to the championships, and the same applies for the participation and anti-doping fees (IPF-By-Laws 105.5.2).

**7 Days before Technical Meeting: 1 NOVEMBER is the latest date for any removal of nominated lifters or cancellation of booked hotel rooms.** If no withdrawal is made 7 days prior to the Technical Meeting of an World championships or Cup, federations are bound to pay the reserved hotel rooms, participation and doping fees for all lifters specified at the final nomination sheet.

***New rules:***

- 1) Preliminary nomination must be sent not later than 60 days before the date of the Championships. Final nomination must be submitted not later than 21 days before the date of the Championships, and it includes only names from the preliminary nomination (i.e. only lifters from the preliminary nomination can be replaced by a substitute. No new nomination will be accepted).***
- 2) According Technical Rules Page 4 item 7 at the final nomination you must definite list the athletes, who takes part. At the Technical meeting you can only delete athletes from your final nomination or change the weight classes. Replacing of athletes through reserve lifters at the Technical meeting is not possible.***

***All lifters are expected to produce passports or other documents at the weigh-in.***
